SAFELY HOME SURVEY - WESTERN-CAPE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT AND PUBLIC WORKS

The Western Cape Department of Transport and Public Works is currently conducting its annual Safely Home Survey, which is a household survey that aims to better understand the factors affecting road safety in the Western Cape. This information is essential to reducing road injuries through improving public policy, law enforcement, road infrastructure and education campaigns. A sample of 3840 drivers, pedestrians and passengers between the ages of 18 and 49 years have been randomly selected across each of the five districts and the City of Cape Town in the Western Cape. This letter serves to inform you that your community has been selected as part of this process and to introduce you to Bearfish Strategic Services, who have been commissioned to do the research and iKapadata, the company that is going to be conducting the interviews.

Once completed, the results of the study will be available on the Western Cape Department of Transport and Public Works' website and will also be sent directly to participants.
