TRAFFIC CIRCLE AWARENESS

#BeSmart #BeSafe

DO'S

- ✓ Yield at the traffic circle before moving
- ✓ Always yield right of way to the motorist/traffic vehicle coming from your right at a traffic circle
- ✓ Use indicators when changing direction
- ✓ Yield right of way to pedestrians at pedestrian crossings
- ✓ When entering a public road, make sure it is safe to do so
- ✓ Keep a safe following distance
- ✓ Keep left around a traffic circle
- ✓ When turning right, pass to the left at a traffic island/circle (two way)



DON'TS

- ✗ Do not stand on pedestrian crossings
- ✗ Do not speed in a traffic circle
- ✗ Do not make a u-turn in a traffic circle
- ✗ Do not park where it is prohibited or a danger to other traffic
- ✗ Do not stop on a red line
- ✗ Do not pick up or drop off in a traffic circle
- ✗ Do not park within 5 metres of a traffic circle/intersection
- ✗ Do not use a cellphone while driving
