Get sorted for recycling. Now it's easy, and free!

Free weekly collection at your doorstep

Saldanha Bay Municipality is now providing free door-to-door recycling collections to householders in your area. Each week on the same day as your refuse removal, your recyclable waste will be collected. No need to sort the different items – just put paper, plastic, glass bottles and tins into the clear bag that you get. All 'wet' food scraps and other waste go as usual into the bin.

Then on refuse day each week, place your clear bag with recyclables next to (or on top of) your refuse bin on the pavement and it will be collected. A new clear bag will be swapped for the full one.

Up to seven more jobs are created locally by recycling waste than by disposing it to landfill.

Follow these steps and get into the recycling routine.

One: During the week, put all your recyclables (paper, plastic, glass bottles, tins) into the clear bags that you're given.

Two: On your weekly refuse removal day, place your clear bag of recyclables next to (or on top of) your wheelie-bin.

Three: The recycling contractor (Wastegro, working on behalf of the Municipality) will remove your bag of recyclables, and leave a fresh clear bag for you to start collecting your next week's recyclables.

Did you know:

South Africa is one of the top recycling countries in the world.

What you can and can't recycle

Yes! - These go into your clear bag.

- ✓ Plastic milk, soft drinks bottles and containers
- ✓ Paper and cardboard (folded and flattened)
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars (no other glass)
- ✓ Metal drinks and food cans
- ✓ Juice or milk boxed containers



No! - These go into your bin.

- ✗ Food waste, scraps and peelings
- ✗ Cling wrap, disposable nappies, toothpaste tubes
- ✗ Wet or food-spoiled paper and cardboard
- ✗ Old clothing and shoes, all other waste.



Put out your bag of recyclables with your bin on refuse collection day.

Helpful hints:

- No other glass except bottles for recycling.
- Flatten cardboard boxes and place beside wheelie-bin.
- Garden refuse, as well as used containers for motor oil, paints, solvents or other hazardous chemicals can be taken for proper disposal to the Vredenburg landfill site.
