Saldanha Bay Municipality is now providing free door-to-door recycling collection services to residents of Vredenburg, Paternoster, Jacobsbaai and Hopefield, as well as Langebaan.

Total recyclable material diverted from landfill by residents from October 2016 to October 2017: 532 tons.

Join in and get sorted for recycling

Recycling bags are available free from the municipal offices at IPIC Centre, Main Road, Vredenburg and at Langebaan municipal offices – bring your rates account along.

When you put out a bag of recyclables along with your refuse on collection day, it will be swapped for a new bag to hold the following week's recyclables.
