- Ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial and inland freshwater ecosystems and their services.
- Promote the implementation of sustainable management of all types of forests, halt deforestation and increase restoration.
- Combat desertification and land degradation.
- Ensure the conservation of mountain ecosystems.
- Reduce the degradation of natural habitats, halt the loss of biodiversity and protect and prevent the extinction of threatened species.
- Promote fair and equitable sharing of the benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources and promote appropriate access to such resources.
- End poaching and trafficking of protected species of flora and fauna.
- Significantly reduce the impact, introduction of and eradicate invasive alien species on land and water ecosystems.
- Integrate ecosystem and biodiversity values into national and local planning, development processes, poverty reduction strategies and accounts.
- Mobilize and increase financial resources to conserve and sustainably use biodiversity and ecosystems.
- Mobilize significant resources at all levels to finance sustainable forest management and provide adequate incentives to developing Countries.
- Enhance global support for efforts to combat poaching and trafficking of protected species.
