NOTICE OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION ON DATABASE

Paragraph 14(1)(a) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Policy states that the municipality must keep a list of accredited prospective providers of goods and services that must be used for the procurement requirements. The Minister of Finance announced in the 2015 budget speech, the development and future use of the Central Supplier Database (CSD) as a way of simplifying the process of doing business with government. The Central Supplier Database (CSD) is the source of all supplier information for all organs of state. The CSD has reduced the exchange of compliance documents in paper form, eliminate multiple registrations with different organs of state, and ultimately reduce the cost for both business and government by enabling electronic registration and verification processes.

The CSD is interfaced with the South African Revenue Service (SARS) to verify tax clearance certificates and the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) for business registration and business ownership information. The CSD will furthermore verify supplier information with the register for tender defaulters and database of restricted suppliers.

Prospective suppliers should self-register on the CSD website www.csd.gov.za. Please ensure that all information is completed upon registration to reduce delays in the procurement process of Saldanha Bay Municipality.

The usage of the CSD came into effect on 01 July 2016. REGISTRATION IS COMPULSORY IN ORDER TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH SALDANHA BAY MUNICIPALITY. The database is used to verify the accreditation of a supplier before an award can be made.
